Henry, & John Hampton, Daughters of John Hampton  
Mar 20 1810 Jim Dec - - In schooling bond: in 1801 - 1804

Book J. 279 - Order to sell the slaves of the est. of John Hampton Jr -  
Mar 8, 1806 - except one Lewis, allotted to his widow Mary Hampton  
and the wife of Wm Jacobs - 4 slaves sold.

Book M p 75, William Hampton of Fairfax all land & personalty  
except negroes sold. After paying debts. all  
slaves & money divided among his 3 daughters  
Penny, Frances, & Mary Hampton.  
Apr 5, 1819. prob. Aug 22, 1820.  
p 370 Dec. Sept 15, 1820. \$ 54. 58. a few hundred  
& farm utensils. - (\$ 1000 + Sales)

"John Hampton born 3 June 1683 in Gloucester County Virg<sup>a.</sup>  
"Margaret Wade daughter to James Wade was born km 1 May 1694  
in New Kent/ Virg<sup>a.</sup> & Married 1 May 1712.

" Henry Hampton born<sup>d.</sup> 5<sup>d</sup> October 1720 in King Wm County  
" Betty Cary born<sup>a.</sup> born<sup>d.</sup> 8 Octbr 1722 & mary<sup>d.</sup> 8 May 1738.

"Docter Henry C. Hampton jun<sup>r.</sup> was born in Prince William Coty  
Virg<sup>a.</sup> 16 Novbr 1754 # & now 83  
"Betsy Plunket born Feb<sup>r.</sup> 1758 & mard 4 May 1779.

" Wm. Hampton sen born in Pr. Wm. Coty Virg<sup>a.</sup> 7 May 1780  
"Malinda Shortridge was born 7 June 1784 & mar'd 1 January 1804.

"Wm Hampton jun<sup>r.</sup> born June 27 1808 & mar'd Sarah Buchanan on 31st.  
August 1828.

"John Hampton died in Fairfax Coty Virg<sup>a.</sup> 18 Jan'y 1747/8  
"Marg Hampton died 17 May 1773 ? ( the pages is so spotted  
this might be 1723, but I don't think so--E.L.M.)

"Henry Hampton sen<sup>r.</sup> died in Pr.Wm. Coty Virg<sup>a.</sup> 7 March 1778  
"Betsy Hampton died 8 July 1761. Evidently Betsy Cary Hampton  
Henry, Sr's wife, and mother of Dr. Henry C. Hampton, your great  
grandfather, Walliam Hampton's grandfather.
